





"I belong to the working class. When we discovered that my daughter had kidney disease, our family was filled with sorrow. It was a devastating blow for me too, as I was poor and lacked the means to afford proper treatment. When Fatima was around 8 years old, she developed a fever. I rushed her to a private hospital in an emergency. The doctors informed us that her kidney was shrinking due to the fever. Upon the doctor's recommendation, we brought her to SIUT. She initially received treatment through medications, but when her condition didn't improve significantly, the doctors advised dialysis." – Fatima's Father

For the past 9 months, Amina is undergoing dialysis at SIUT. The dedicated efforts of the doctors are yielding positive results, and Amina's recovery is progressing gradually. Although her dream of playing in a cricket match remains unfulfilled, we hold onto the hope that Amina will find a donor soon.

#### California: Chapter Lead: Dr. Bilal Hameed


Launched in 2024, California's chapter is set to amplify impact, mobilize donors, and engage advocates to support accessible medical care.




