Happy 2023!

I want to personally thank each of you for your longstanding support of SIUT North America. Your compassion for patients at SIUT shown through your generosity has meant so much to us.

As a result, we were able to fund **\$4.16 million** to help SIUT purchase state-of-the-art medical equipment for its patients' treatments last year. The prime example is the Elekta Unity Linear Accelerator with integrated High Field MRI (MR/LINAC). This radiotherapy machine fully integrates two different technologies in a single platform: a state-of-the-art high-field MR imaging system and a next-generation linear accelerator, enabling real-time personalization and precision in radiation therapy and expanding treatment options for all cancers including hard-to-treat cancers.



Another key acquisition that has revolutionized the quality of surgical care at SIUT is the Versius Robotic Surgery System. In 2021, SIUTNA contributed \$3 million towards this cutting-edge minimal access surgery technology which is used to treat urological, hepatobiliary, colorectal and cancer diseases. We are extremely proud to announce that SIUT successfully operated over 1200 robotic surgeries in 2022 - proving yet again SIUT's commitment to exceptional care for all its patients, free of cost.



These accomplishments are only possible with support from friends like you. Looking ahead, our vision is to reach even higher fundraising targets to help meet the escalating need for health care services. 






IMPACT BY SIUT NORTH AMERICA


